- microphones, stands & cables (see channel plan)
- our guitar player Max needs a case to put his amp on (min. 40 x 60 cm, height 15-30 cm)
- mounting bar behind the band setup for our backdrop (6,0 x 4,0 m)

2. PA

- prof. fullrange PA adequate to location's size & amount of expected visitors
- 105 db(A) at foh-position without clipping
- please provide spare equipment: cables, microphones, di, stands etc.

3. FOH

- prof. min. 24 Ch mixing console (inserts, low cut, pad, min. 8 aux, parametric EQ) digital or analog
- a nice selection of outboard processors (gate, comp, fx) if FOH console will be analog
- the steadytones travel without their own foh mixing engineer & need a qualified & motivated operator
- we would be grateful if the mixing engineer could listen to one or two of our songs in order to get a good feel for it :-) thank you very much
- we'd love to record our shows, please provide two XLR male connectors with the console's stereo master signal attached (if possible without master EQ)

4. Monitoring

- 5 way monitoring, properly EQ'd
- 5 wedges 12/1 minimum (we don't need any Drumfill, powerful wedges are perfect)
- in case of a separate monitor mixing position, a qualified & motivated operator must be provided

5. Lighting

- light operator
- good lighting of singers is very important to us
- the rest is up to you, have fun!!!

6. Other

- min. 2 stage hands for backline handling before & after the concert
- local crew has to be available during setup & soundcheck
